Creative ideas to design effective feedbacks in e-Learning courses

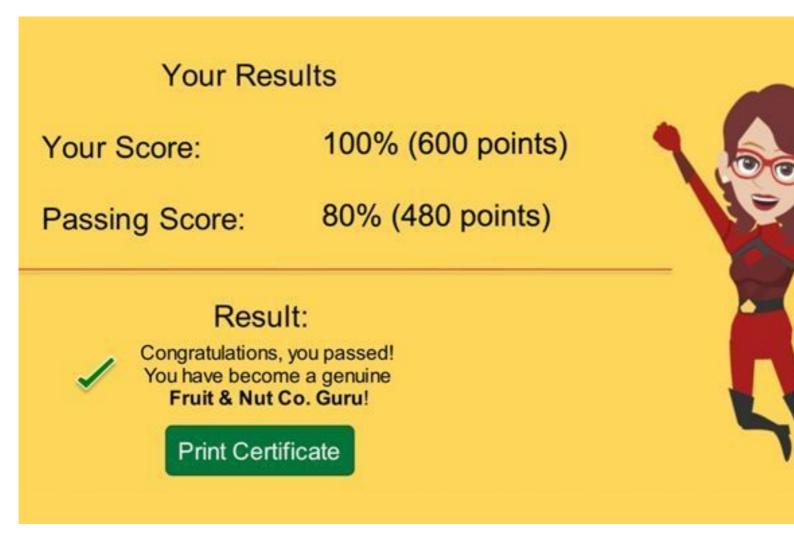
How to use graphics, animations, icons and other graphic ideas to design effective feedbacks to quizzes ad to results pages

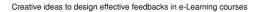
